The Minnesota Elks Youth Camp is located near Nisswa, Minnesota on Pelican Lake. (Directions coming from the south) Take highway 371 north of Brainerd about 10 miles and turn East on County Road 13 by Schaefer's Grocery Store. Go about 6 miles on #13 until a T in the road at County Road 4. Go left on #4 for about 1 mile until County Road 118. Go Right on County Road 118 for about 1/2 mile and come in the first Elks Camp entrance, which is marked with a sign.
